ABOUT THE UPCOMING SYMPOSIUM

The International Symposium on GeoInformatics for Spatial-Infrastructure Development in Earth & Allied Sciences (GIS-IDEAS) is scheduled to take place in HCMC, Vietnam, 9-11 November 2006. This is follow-up to the very successful GIS-IDEAS Symposium held in Hanoi, Vietnam in September 2002 and September 2004 (<http://gisws.media.osaka-cu.ac.jp/gisideas/>). The main theme of the GIS-IDEAS 2006 is "**Geoinformatics for Regional Sustainable Development**". The symposium will also focus on development of spatial databases and analysis of spatial data for modelling and simulation of processes related to our natural and social environment. GIS-IDEAS Symposium in 2006 not only aims to serve as a forum for scientific exchanges but also as a conduit for technology transfer through tutorial sessions. Further, in order to promote a better understanding of local needs, field excursions and visits to scientific institutes in Vietnam are also being planned. The language of the conference will be English.
