ABSTRACT

From Living Angkor Road, the advanced technologies to collect and analyze archaeological and cultural information of people along the ancient road had been applied. From the previous study, we had studied to identify historic roadway, communication links and human settlement of Khmer empire from Angkor to Phimai. The surveys had been conducted both in Thailand and Cambodia sides. The ethnographical systematic survey in both sides, Cambodia and Thailand were developed, which is one of the most valuable information for future studies of the region, and it was the first time for such a study to take place across the border of Thailand and Cambodia after the French scholars had done such a study almost 100 years ago.
